# SCHEELS Pickleball Courts

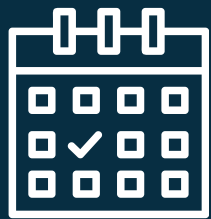
Welcome to the Scheels Pickleball Courts. We are glad you are here! Help us maintain a safe and enjoyable environment for all by following these rules:

## RESPECTING THE SPACE



Report injuries to staff immediately



Courts 1 & 4 are open play. Other courts by reservation only.



Youth under 12 must be with an adult



Respect others



Use garbage cans



Use headphones



Report spills to staff immediately



Shirt and clean, proper shoes required

## THIS AREA DOES NOT ALLOW



Gum, sunflower seeds, or spitting



Skateboards, bikes, rollerblades or scooters



Glass containers



Metal cleats, spikes or screw in studs

# Open Play Courts Information

---

## COURTS 1 & 4 ARE FOR OPEN PLAY

- The Fargo Park District will not assist with rack system/court usage disputes on open play courts.
- Court time is limited to two games to 11, win by 1.
  - At conclusion of second game, exit court immediately.
  - To play again, place your paddle in first available opening in the paddle rack system (L-R) and wait on benches near open play courts.
- The next waiting group will take the first available court. All players must be present when their courts become available.
  - Groups must be 2 (singles) or 4 (doubles) players. All players must be present when their court becomes available.
  - Groups of 3 must immediately obtain a 4th player or relinquish the open court to the next group. However, they may continue to hold their place on the paddle rack system while they search for a 4th player.
- Singles players are encouraged to team up with another singles group to form a doubles game. This helps maximize the number of people playing at all times. However, if players wish to play a singles game, they should put their paddles in the 2nd and 4th slot on the paddle rack, leaving the 1st and 3rd slot empty.
